# On and Off the Water

### **All Club Members and Guests**

Dovey Yacht Club | Clwb Hwylio Dyfi expects all Club Members and Guests to show respect and understanding to each other, treat everyone equally and conduct themselves in a way on and off the water that reflects the positive welcoming ethos and principles of a safe volunteer led club.

Abusive, aggressive or discriminatory language or behaviour, or a lack of respect for other people and their property, will not be tolerated. Misconduct should be reported to a Club Official and may lead to disciplinary action.

The club implements the RYA Racing Charter and members will be expected to sail in compliance with it.

#### All Club members and guests are expected to:

- Abide by the Club's by articles of association and by laws
- □ Follow the Club's latest Safety and Operating Procedures (SOPs), Codes of Conduct and Policies particularly Safety, Safeguarding (children and adults), Social Media and Photography.
- Key documentation is available on the main page of the Club website under the first tab 'About DYC' then 'Club Policies/Legal' <u>https://www.doveyyachtclub.org.uk/policies</u>
- □ Treat members and visitors with respect and understanding, regardless of age, disability, gender identity, race, religion or belief, sex or sexual orientation.
- Avoid the use of language that others may find offensive, whether on club premises, at a club event, or when using the club's social media channels. Refer to Social Media Policy and Code of Conduct.
- □ Encourage all members to play as full a role in the Club as they wish to and support them in developing their skills and experience.
- **Q** Recognise the contribution of coaches, instructors, officials, paid employees and volunteers.
- Prioritise the safety and wellbeing of participants.
- Promote courtesy to other water users.
- □ Use established procedures where there is a genuine concern or dispute. Key reference documents are the current SOPs and the three policies Disciplinary and Complaints, Grievance, and Equality.

#### All Club members and guests can expect to:

- □ Feel welcome and valued.
- Be respected and treated fairly.
- Be listened to and kept informed.
- Be involved and contribute towards decisions within the Club.
